The Ten Commandments

Scripture reading: Exodus 20:1-17 (New International Version)



¹ And God spoke all these words:

² "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

³ "You shall have no other gods before me.

⁴ "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. ⁵ You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, ⁶ but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

⁷ "You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

⁸ "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. ⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day is a sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns. ¹¹ For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

¹² "Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

¹³ "You shall not murder.

¹⁴ "You shall not commit adultery.

¹⁵ "You shall not steal.

¹⁶ "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

¹⁷ "You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the last couple of weeks, I have been doing research for an essay on the Ten Commandments for my Theology paper with the University of Otago. I am sure that we have all seen that wonderful adaptation of the Moses story with Charlton Heston, as Moses, and Yul Brynner as Ramses. The film's climax occurs with Moses upon Mt Sinai, where there is thunder, there is lightening. Moses is tired from the long climb, he is drenched. But God has not spoken to him even though God summoned him. Moses is at his wits end. He is standing on a ledge and starts to berate God. Suddenly what looks like embers from a fire start to form and swirl. Then a voice comes from within the swarm of embers. As Moses watches a fiery finger writes words on stone and God's voice echoes out, "You shall have no other gods before me."

These words are fixed in stone. They are laws that God has made for his people. They are like laws that our Parliament make. Break them and you end up in prison. Or so I thought. Let me share with you how this view has evolved.

Voters will elect 120 members to the unicameral New Zealand House of Representatives under the mixed-member proportional (MMP) voting system, a proportional representation system in which 72 members will be elected from single-member electorates and 48 members from closed party lists.
