Pentecost Sunday



The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

2 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. ² Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

⁵ Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. ⁶ When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard their own language being spoken. ⁷ Utterly amazed, they asked: "Aren't all these who are speaking Galileans? ⁸ Then how is it that each of us hears them in our native language? ⁹ Parthians, Medes and Elamites; residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰ Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome ¹¹ (both Jews and converts to Judaism); Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!" ¹² Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?" ¹³ Some, however, made fun of them and said, "They have had too much wine."

Peter Addresses the Crowd

¹⁴ Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd: "Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. ¹⁵ These people are not drunk, as you suppose. It's only nine in the morning! ¹⁶ No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel:

¹⁷ "'In the last days, God says,

I will pour out my Spirit on all people.

Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams.

- ¹⁸ Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy.
- ¹⁹ I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke.
- The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and glorious day of the Lord.
- ²¹ And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'

Pastoral Reflection

Hello, friends, who love St Johns

Happy Pentecost Sunday. We are finally here. We have been waiting for this day for the last 7 Sundays. It is so great to be with you this morning on this Pentecost Sunday.

Here is an amazing theological fact, in Exodus when the law is given 3000 people were slain, but in Acts when the Holy Spirit was poured about 3000 people were cut to the heart. It was an amazing thing. The disciples were sitting in the up room, the same upper room where Jesus and them had had their last meal, where Jesus had said things like:

"I am the way, and the truth, and the life..." and "... believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; but if you do not, then believe me because of the works themselves..." and "... peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid..."

It was also where Jesus had washed their feet, and it was also the place that Judas had betrayed Jesus... they are there waiting. We now know that there is an extra apostle that has been added — Matthias, had replaced Judas... they were waiting for God's spirit to show up, but it is not just the twelve disciples... the whole community was there.

And that is the question about the Spirit – "What does this mean?" In other words, "What's going on here?" It was their question, and it is our question today. I like the way Luke resolves in verse 13 he says,

"Some however made fun of them and said they have had so much wine...."

God's spirit has been poured out and the effects is so dramatic that they don't have any categories except to associate it with intoxication. What about you. What comes to mind when you hear the word Pentecost?

The cupcakes are \$2:00 each.


